Valuable objects	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Authorisation from the services of Fine Arts and Antiques</li> </ul>		Export of any objects proceeding the Punic - Carthaginian - Roman period is strictly forbidden. Valuable objects include antiques, jewels, paintings, and collections.
Plants and products	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Phytosanitary certificate</li> </ul>	Importation and exportation are allowed duty free.
